EFG EXTENDS PARTNERSHIP WITH TIFFANY CHAN TSZ-CHING

New term doubles in value of current agreement to support the pride of Hong Kong on the LPGA Tour

HONG KONG (9 MAY, 2018) – Swiss private Bank EFG today announced a three-year extension to its long-standing partnership with LPGA rookie Tiffany Chan Tsz-ching. Hong Kong's number one golfer will continue to represent EFG as an EFG Global Sport Ambassador until at least 2021 in a deal worth double the value of the current agreement.

The 24-year-old Chan, who became the first golfer from Hong Kong to make the LPGA after finishing second at the qualifying school in Florida last December, has been supported by EFG since 2008 first as a participant at an EFG-sponsored Hong Kong Golf Association clinic, and then as a beneficiary of the EFG Young Golfers' Foundation. Recognising her talent, passion, and commitment to the game, EFG took on the leading role to support her through her amateur and college careers, which ended with a flourish thanks to an impressive 37th place at the Rio Olympic Games, and semi-final and quarter-final finishes at the NCAA team and individual championships respectively.

Having made five cuts of the eight LPGA tournaments she has entered this season, the Tuen Mun native said:

“EFG has been with me every step of the way since I was in my early teens when I dreamt of being a professional golfer. I am thrilled to be able to continue my journey with them who have been instrumental in supporting me through my toughest moments. LPGA Tour is the biggest stage of all for women's golf and the road ahead will not be easy. No one knows me better than Albert and his team, and having them by my side have always been, and will continue to be, the biggest confidence booster for me.”

The nine-year, and ongoing, partnership makes this one of the longest in the history of ladies' golf in Hong Kong. Asia Pacific Chief Executive for EFG, Albert Chiu, commented:

“We are delighted to announce our next chapter with Tiffany as she continues to establish herself on the LPGA Tour. EFG and its support of golf have always been about nurturing home grown local talents and giving them every opportunity to reach their full potential so that one day they could represent Hong Kong and make us all very proud. It has an amazing ride see Tiffany blossom from an enthusiastic teenager with a real hunger to succeed to now, an LPGA

pro. We are honoured and humbled to have contributed to her growth and development and look forward to overcoming challenges together on and off the course in years to come.”

EFG’s golf portfolio in Hong Kong also includes title sponsorship of the EFG Hong Kong Ladies Open, which takes place later this week on 11-13 May at the Hong Kong Golf Club. In addition, as part of its ambitious plans to develop its golf portfolio across Southeast Asia, the bank also confirmed a one-year sponsorship deal with top Singaporean professional golfer Koh Sock Hwee, who is a member of the China LPGA Tour, while Winnie Ng, a top amateur from Malaysia, will take up EFG’s sponsor’s invite this weekend.
